Innovative crop breeding method to meet global demand for grains

Crop grain yields are stalling due to climate change, while the global demand for grains is expected to double by 2050.

Plant breeding researchers from The University of Western Australia's Institute of Agriculture, in collaboration with animal breeding researchers at University of New England (UNE), have developed a novel crop breeding method that achieved very high rates of genetic gain in canola in Australia and Canada.







Clinical trial for new stroke therapy returns positive results after healthy volunteer dosing

Participant dosing in the Phase 1 clinical trial to test the safety of ARG-007 has been completed, with healthy participants showing no serious adverse events.

This neuroprotective peptide drug developed by researchers at the Perron Institute and The University of Western Australia is a novel therapeutic aimed at reducing brain tissue death after ischaemic stroke.

Study points to potential new treatment for osteoporosis

Research led by The University of Western Australia has identified a new type of human protein known as an ADR3 i-body that could be used to stop bone breakdown and as a treatment for osteoporosis.

Professor Jiake Xu, from UWA's School of Biomedical Sciences, said that osteoporosis is a common disease characterised by the increased break down of bone leading to a higher risk of fracture.
