Scientists break new record after finding world's deepest fish

At a depth of more than eight kilometres underwater, a new record for the deepest fish ever filmed and the deepest fish ever caught has been set by scientists from The University of Western Australia and Japan. In August 2022, the research ship DSSV Pressure Drop undertook a two-month expedition to the deep trenches around Japan in the north Pacific Ocean.

Telethon support for spinal muscular atrophy research

Molecular genetics research to develop more effective treatments for the neurodegenerative disorder spinal muscular atrophy (SMA) has received funding from the Channel 7 Telethon Trust, announced at a recent beneficiary event. Spinal muscular atrophy is an inherited, progressive and lifelimiting rare disease. Debilitating and often fatal, it affects approximately one in 10,000 individuals and is the leading genetic cause of death among infants.

WA leads national approach to finding the causes of several debilitating diseases

Blood cancers, intellectual disability, cerebral palsy, repeated miscarriages and neuromuscular diseases. For some sufferers these are inherited conditions caused by the presence of specific genes, not yet identified.

The Medical Research Future Fund has allocated near to its maximum amount for this type of grant, \$5m, to a young researcher in Perth to try and solve the genetic mystery that causes these rare, devastating conditions.
