


Patent Box Consultation

In the 2021 Australian Federal Budget, it was announced that the Treasury will introduce a patent box for eligible corporate income associated with new patents in the medical and biotechnology sectors. The patent box will apply to companies for income years commencing on or after 1 July 2022. Consultation on the design of the patent box system has now been opened and will close 16 August 2021. Another Successful Event for Life Sciences WA


